My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

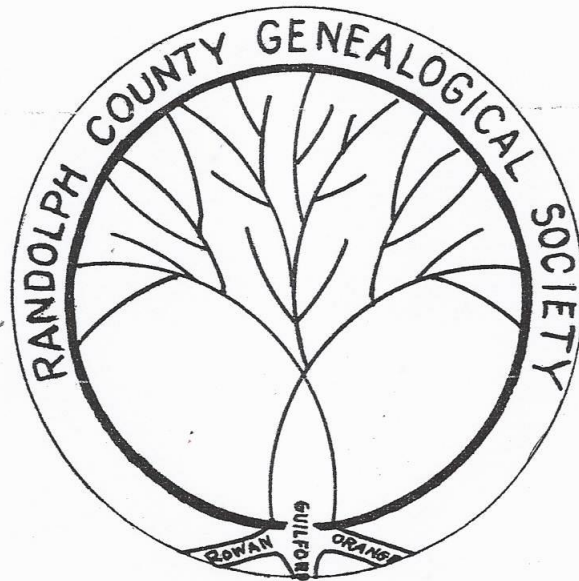
Michael Luther enlisted December 15, 1776, served as a private in Captain Duvall's Company, Colonel Baker Johnston's Maryland Regiment; was in the battle of Piscataway and was discharged April 1, 1777. He enlisted August 15, 1777, served as a private in Captain Hilary's Company, Colonel Baker Johnston's Maryland Regiment; was in the battle of Germantown and was discharged December 25, 1777. He enlisted in June 1781, served as a private in Captain Burged's Maryland Company and was discharged in April, 1782.

Equity of Randolph County.

The Petition of Daniel LUTHER, Gardner SHAW and his wife Deborah, William STOUT and his wife Selina, Henry WOOLEVER and his wife Barbary, Godfrey LUTHER, Abraham LUTHER, Caleb LUTHER, Josiah LUTHER, Mary Ann LUTHER, George LUTHER, Godfrey LUTHER, Abraham LUTHER, Hale SHAW and his wife Elizabeth, James OVERTON and his wife Margaret, Abraham COCHRANE and his wife Rebecca, Fielding KENDALL and Ezekiel LASSITER.

Your Petitioners respectfully show to your Honour that in the year 1834 Michael LUTHER died at the place of his residence in this County having made his will in due form of law to pass lands which will has been proved in the County Court of Randolph whereby he devised to his wife Mary and to the Petitioners Daniel, Deborah and Selina and to Anna another of the testator's daughters, all his lands and tenements to be kept together during the life of their mother (naming the said Mary his widow and the said Daniel, Deborah, Selina and Anna his and her children) and after her death to be equally divided between the four by force of which devise your Petitioners are advised by their counsel and therefore state to your Honour that the said Mary, Daniel, Deborah, Selina and Anna were seized of all the testators lands as joint tenants during the life of his widow Mary and after her death the last named Petitioners were seized as Joint tenants in fee simple of the same. The widow of the testator is dead and his daughter Anna one of the devisees above named has died since the death of the testator, unmarried and without issue.

The above named Daniel, Deborah, Selina and Anna and Barbary, wife of Henry WOOLEVER, were the children of the testator by his last wife Mary herein before named, but the testator had been married to a wife before his marriage with the said Mary and by his first wife he had several children ToWit: Your Petitioner Godfrey LUTHER, Abraham LUTHER, Jonathan LUTHER who died in the testator's lifetime and left his children and heirs at law Your Petitioners Caleb LUTHER, Josiah LUTHER and Mary Ann LUTHER - Michael LUTHER who also died before the testator leaving his children and his heirs at law, your Petitioners George LUTHER, Godfrey LUTHER, Abraham LUTHER, Elizabeth who has since married your Petitioner Hale SHAW. Margaret who has married your Petitioner James OVERTON, Rebecca who has married your Petitioner Abraham COCHRANE and your Petitioners are advised and therefore state to your Honour that the one fourth part of the lands devised by the

testator upon the death of his daughter Anna, descended to the surviving children of the testator by his first wife and their heirs of them who are dead. Your Petitioners further show to your Honour that Daniel LUTHER one of the devisees herein before named in the year 1844 conveyed to your Petitioners Fielding KENDALL and Ezekiel LASSITER all his right and title to the land devised to him by the testator and to the land which descended to him from his sister Anna.

The testator died seized in fee simple of a tract of land in Randolph County lying on the waters of Little River adjoining the lands of John GRAVES, Esquire and Henry WOOLEVER containing about two hundred acres and of another tract of land of one hundred acres or thereabouts adjoining the lands of Daniel LUTHER, Henry WOOLEVER and William HAMMOND.

The value of the tracts of land herein before described would be greatly impaired by a division among your Petitioners and a joint occupation of it by the Petitioners would not be convenient or profitable. In consideration of the premises your Petitioners pray your Honour to order that the tracts of land herein before mentioned be sold by the Clerk and Master of this Court and that he report to the Court what he shall do...

Get order to sell a tract of land on waters of Little River devised by Michael LUTHER to Daniel and Deborah, wife of Gardner SHAW, Sarah, wife of William STOUT and his daughter Anna.

The following is the clause of the will relating to this land "I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary and my son Daniel and daughters Deborah and Sarah & Anna all my lands & tenaments together with my stock of horses, cows, sheep & hogs to be kept together during the life of their mother and after her death to be equally divided between the four." Soon after the death of the testator Anna died without issue in the life of the testator's widow, who has recently died.

Godfrey LUTHER, Abram LUTHER, Michael LUTHER who is dead leaving the following children - George LUTHER, Godfrey, Abram, Elizabeth wife of Hale SHAW, Margaret wife of James OVERTON, Jonathan who is dead leaving the following children - Caleb, Josiah, Mary Ann - The said Godfrey, Abram, Michael and Jonathan being children of the testator by a former marriage. The said Daniel, Deborah and Barbary wife of Henry WOOLEVER, Sarah & Anna, being his children by his latter wife.

Petition to sell, tenant in possession to continue till he gets off Crop - say 1st. Oct. next.

Jacob LUTHER & John GRAVES, Esquire, will be at Court in early part week & will make the affidavit required to be ex parte petition.

The parties say that the Jacob place purchased by William STOUT is not mentioned in the will of Michael LUTHER.

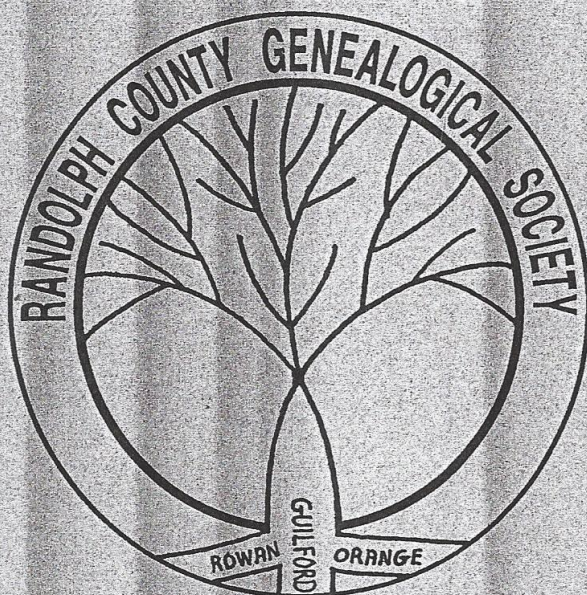

Administrator's bond. 8 Nov 1836, for Henry WOOLEVER. Security Herbert SPENCER.

LUTHER, MICHAEL- 1842

Summons, 13 May 1838, to Daniel LUTHER, exec. of will, to answer complaint of Henry WOOLEVER, admin. of Mary Ann LUTHER, for \$75 & interest, per note.

Petition for sale for partition. Michael LUTHER died 1834, leaving a widow, Mary. He had been married before, leaving heirs by both marriages, who request a sale.

Affidavit of Daniel LUTHER, Nov term 1842. Mary LUTHER, widow of Michael, became, on account of age and infirmity, unable to attend to her business and is in fact a lunatic.

Order of sale, no date.

Master's report, Fall term 1846, Court of Equity. Land was sold 2 July. The 350 acres where Daniel LUTHER lives, which Michael LUTHER held by four grants from the state (1 for 150 acres, 1 for 100 acres, two for 50 acres each), was sold to John GRAVES, security Nathan SPENCER. The 100 acres called the Jacob LUTHER tract sold to Wm. STOUT, security Daniel LUTHER.

Decree confirming master's report, no date.

Petition of Daniel LUTHER, Gardner SHAW & wife Deborah, Wm. STOUT & wife Sarah. Michael's will gave land to his wife Mary, and the petitioners, his children, and also a daughter, Anna, who died shortly thereafter, unmarried without issue. The widow has since died, and her share descended to her children, who wish a sale for partition. No date.

Affidavit, no date. LUTHER, SHAW, and STOUT are each entitled to 1/3. The land cannot be divided without injury to the parties, so must be sold.

The deceased had land that descended to Louisa, Eliz., Henry, James, Wilbourn & Fanny LYNDON, children & heirs, all minors by their guardian Mary LYNDON.

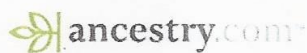

Sir:

I advise you from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, W. 4721, it appears that Michael Luther was born, March 7, 1751, in Strasburg, Germany.

About 1759, his parents, names not shown, emigrated to America and settled near Alexandria, Virginia, and later in Frederick County, Maryland, where the soldier resided when he enlisted, December 15, 1776, served as a private in Captain Duvall's Company, Colonel Baker Johnston's Maryland Regiment, was in the battle of Piscataway, and was discharged about April 1, 1777.

He enlisted, August 15, 1777, served as a private in Captain Hilary's Company, Colonel Baker Johnston's Maryland Regiment, was in the battle of Germantown, and was discharged, December 25, 1777.

He enlisted in June, 1781, served as a private in Captain Burges(?) Maryland Company, and was discharged

in April, 1782.

He was allowed pension on his application executed November 5, 1832, while a resident of Randolph County, North Carolina, where he had lived since January, 1790. He died, October 10, 1834.

The soldier married, December 10, 1789, in Frederick County, Maryland, Mary Kindle. She was allowed pension on her application executed August 3, 1840, while a resident of Randolph County, North Carolina, and then aged about eighty years.

One George Luther was a resident of ^{Vineyard} Martha's Vinyard, Chatham County, North Carolina, in 1841, no relationship stated.

The soldier's brother, George, who also served in the Revolution, was a resident of Randolph County, North Carolina, in 1833.

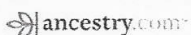
